



TWIDDLEMUFF INSTRUCTIONS

Materials:

This muff pattern is perfect for using up left over and odd balls of wool.

Needles:

5.5mm or 6.0mm

Directions:

Cuff: Cast on 40 stitches using 2 strands of double knitting wool, (you can also use 1 strand of chunky wool)

Muff Body: Continuing with stocking stitch and using up oddments of various textures of wool ie chunky, mohair, ribbon. Work until work measures 23 inches. Cast off.

Decoration and finishing:

Now is the time if you want to decorate the muff body with beads, flowers, zips, loops etc. Sew on with button thread or double strands of sewing thread. Reinforce any beads or buttons with a backing of firm fabric to prevent the knitting stitches being pulled out.

Neatly join the sides together with pearl side facing you.

Turn inside out.

Push cuff up inside the muff body.

Neatly sew together the two ends.
